### **211 Homeless Data (FY2011-2012) - Total # of Homeless Calls 542**

- 51% reported that they had never been homeless before
- 672 total children
- Family Make-up:
  - 39% Single Females
  - 39% Female Head of Household
  - 10% Two-Parent Household
  - 9% Single Males
  - 2% Couple– no children
  - 1% Male– Head of Household

### **211 Homeless Data (FY2012-2013) - Total # of Homeless Calls 876**

- 55% reported that they had never been homeless before
- 1,006 total children were in families that needed shelter
- Family Make-up:
  - 34% Female Head of Household
  - 26% Single Females
  - 21% Two-Parent Household
  - 13% Single Males
  - 4% Couple– no children
  - 2% Male Head of Household

### **211 Homeless Data (FY2013-2014) - Total # of Homeless Calls 957**

- 59% reported that they had never been homeless before
- 974 total children were in families that needed shelter
- Family Make-up:
  - 30% Female Head of Household
  - 27% Two-Parent Household
  - 24% Single Females
  - 13% Single Males
  - 3% Couple– no children
  - 3% Male Head of Household
