[Narrative]

CP JOHN GONZALES CALLED 911 STATING THERE WAS A FORT WAYNE CITY OFFICER ON SCENE, LATER IDENTIFIED AS SUSPECT #2 DERRICK WESTFIELD, THAT HAD HIT HIS SON, SUSPECT #2 [REDACTED] GONZALES. UPON MY ARRIVAL, I WAS MET OUTSIDE IN THE DRIVEWAY BY JOHN, [REDACTED], DERRICK AND OTHER PARTICIPANT ADRIAN LOWE. I ASKED JOHN WHAT WAS GOING ON. JOHN STATED HE WAS INSIDE HIS HOME, LOCATED AT [REDACTED] MILLENIUM CROSSING, WHEN HIS NEPHEW ADRIAN RAN INSIDE AND TOLD HIM THAT THERE WAS A MAN OUTSIDE FIGHTING WITH [REDACTED]. JOHN SAID HE WENT OUTSIDE AND SAW DERRICK ON TOP OF [REDACTED] HOLDING HIM DOWN ON THE GROUND. JOHN SAID HE TOLD DERRICK TO GET OFF OF HIS SON AND INFORMED HIM THAT HE IS A PARKVIEW HOSPITAL POLICE OFFICER. JOHN SAID DERRICK TOLD HIM HE WAS AN OFFICER AS WELL AND THEN GOT OFF OF [REDACTED] AND LET HIM STAND UP. JOHN THEN CALLED 911.

I THEN SPOKE WITH DERRICK AND ASKED HIM WHAT HAD TAKEN PLACE. DERRICK SAID HE AND HIS FIANCEE, WITNESS TAMECCA CHAPMAN, WERE DRIVING IN HIS CAR AT THE ROUND-A-BOUT ON AUBURN RD AT UNION CHAPEL. DERRICK SAID A VEHICLE, LATER

IDENTIFIED AS VEHICLE #1 A GOLD CHRYSLER 300, CAME UP BEHIND HIM AT A HIGH RATE OF SPEED FLASHING ITS LIGHTS AT HIM. DERRICK SAID HE BRAKE CHECKED THE CAR AND IT PASSED HIM ON AUBURN RD. HE SAID IT THEN CONTINUED NORTH UNTIL IT TURNED INTO THE FALCON CREEK ADDITION, WHERE HE WAS PULLING IN AS WELL, BECAUSE HE ALSO LIVES IN THAT ADDITION. DERRICK SAID HE WAS BEHIND THE VEHICLE UNTIL IT PULLED INTO [REDACTED] MILLENIUM CROSSING. DERRICK STATED HE HAD SLOWED DOWN AS HE WAS DRIVING BY AND THE 2 SUBJECTS FROM THE OTHER CAR, ADRIAN AND [REDACTED], BEGAN APPROACHING HIS CAR AND YELLING "WHY DID YOU CUT ME OFF?" DERRICK SAID HE PARKED HIS CAR AND GOT OUT TO SPEAK WITH THEM. DERRICK SAID THEY TOLD HIM THEY WERE MINORS AND SHOULD NOT HAVE CUT THEM OFF BACK AT THE ROUND-A-BOUT. DERRICK SAID ADRIAN WAS AGGRESSIVELY IN HIS FACE SO HE EXTENDED HIS ARM STRAIGHT OUT MAKING CONTACT WITH ADRIAN AND TOLD HIM TO STAY BACK. DERRICK SAID [REDACTED] THEN PUNCHED HIM ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF HIS FACE. DERRICK SAID THERE WAS A STRUGGLE AND THEY WERE FIGHTING WHEN HE AND [REDACTED] ENDED UP ON THE GROUND WHERE HE HELD [REDACTED] DOWN UNTIL HIS PARENT, JOHN, CAME OUTSIDE. DERRICK SAID HE TOLD JOHN THAT HE WAS A FORT WAYNE POLICE OFFICER. DERRICK'S CHEEK AREA APPEARED TO BE SLIGHTLY SWOLLEN.

I THEN SPOKE WITH [REDACTED] WHO TOLD ME THAT HE WAS IN THE PASSENGER SEAT OF ADRIAN'S CAR AND THEY WERE IN THE ROUND-A-BOUT WHEN VEHICLE #2, DERRICK'S GMC SUV, CUT THEM OFF ALMOST CAUSING AN ACCIDENT. [REDACTED] SAID ADRIAN TAILED THE SUV AND FLASHED HIS BRIGHTS AT HIM FOR A WHILE BEFORE HE PASSED HIM. [REDACTED] SAID THE SUV FOLLOWED THEM HOME AND STOPPED IN FRONT OF THEIR HOUSE. [REDACTED] SAID THEY ASKED THE FEMALE PASSENGER WHY THEY CUT THEM OFF AND THEN DERRICK CAME AROUND FROM THE DRIVERS SIDE AND STARTED PUSHING THEM. [REDACTED] SAID HE TOLD DERRICK THAT HE'S A MINOR BUT THAT DERRICK THEN SHOVED ADRIAN SO HE PUNCHED DERRICK IN THE FACE. [REDACTED] SAID DERRICK SHOVED HIM INTO ADRIAN'S CAR AND THEN DOWN ONTO THE GROUND, KNOCKING OFF AND BREAK ING HIS GLASSES. [REDACTED] SAID DERRICK WOULD NOT GET OFF OF HIM AND CHOKED HIM IN A HEAD LOCK UNTIL HIS FATHER, JOHN, CAME OUTSIDE AND TOLD DERRICK TO GET OFF OF HIM. [REDACTED] HAD A BLOODY NOSE AND SOME SCRATCHES ON HIS FACE AND ALSO ON THE BACK OF HIS HEAD. HE ALSO HAD A SCRAPE ON HIS FINGER AND COMPLAINED OF PAIN IN HIS BACK.

I THEN SPOKE TO ADRIAN AND ASKED HIM TO TELL ME WHAT HAD TAKEN PLACE. ADRIAN SAID THEY WERE DRIVING IN THE ROUND-A-BOUT ON AUBURN RD WHEN DERRICK DROVE HIS VEHICLE OUT IN FRONT OF THEM. ADRIAN SAID HE FLASHED HIS BRIGHTS AT HIM AND THAT DERRICK BRAKE CHECKED HIM, SO HE WENT AROUND HIM AND CONTINUED ON INTO THE FALCON CREEK ADDITION. ADRIAN SAID WHEN HE PULLED INTO [REDACTED]'S DRIVEWAY AND THEY WERE GETTING OUT OF THE CAR, DERRICK PULLED UP NEXT TO THEM AND ROLLED DOWN THE PASSENGER WINDOW. ADRIAN SAID HE ASKED WHY THEY HAD CUT HIM OFF AND DERRICK STOPPED THE CAR AND GOT OUT. ADRIAN SAID DERRICK WAS AGGRESSIVELY IN HIS FACE SAYING "DO SOMETHING" A COUPLE TIMES BEFORE HE PUSHED HIM. ADRIAN SAID [REDACTED] TOLD DERRICK "DON'T PUSH MY COUSIN" AND THEN DERRICK PUSHED [REDACTED] AS WELL. ADRIAN SAID DERRICK AND [REDACTED] STARTED FIGHTING SO HE RAN INSIDE TO GET JOHN. ADRIAN SAID HE SAW DERRICK HAD [REDACTED] IN A HEAD LOCK AND THAT [REDACTED] WAS SAYING HE COULDN'T BREATHE. ADRIAN SAID HE TOLD DERRICK TO LET HIM GO AND THAT WHEN JOHN CAME OUTSIDE HE HAD TO PULL [REDACTED] OUT FROM DERRICK.

FINALLY, I SPOKE WITH WITNESS TAMECCA CHAPMAN, DERRICK'S FIANCEE WHO HAD BEEN IN THE PASSENGER SEAT OF HIS CAR DURING THE INCIDENT. TAMECCA SAID THEY HAD ENDED UP IN FRONT OF THE CHRYSLER IN THE ROUND-A-BOUT ON AUBURN AT UNION CHAPEL AND THE CHRYSLER BEGAN TAILGATING THEM. TAMECCA SAID THEY PASSED THEM AT A HIGH SPEED AND THEN TURNED INTO THE SAME NEIGHBORHOOD THEY LIVE IN. TAMECCA SAID WHEN THE CHRYSLER PULLED INTO A DRIVEWAY, THEY WERE STILL BEHIND THE VEHICLE WHEN THE 2 OCCUPANTS GOT OUT AND STARTED YELLING AT THEM. TAMECCA SAID DERRICK GOT OUT TO TALK TO THEM AND [REDACTED] AND ADRIAN WERE CUSSING HIM OUT AND YELLING AT HIM. TAMECCA SAID ONE OF THEM PUNCHED DERRICK SO DERRICK PUT HIM ON THE GROUND AND

TOLD THE OTHER ONE TO GO GET HIS FATHER.

AT THIS TIME, ALLEN COUNTY POLICE OFFICERS STEVE STUCKEY#280, CODY CASHMAN #326, ADAM ROGERS #323 AND CORPORAL SCOTT UETRECHT #215 WERE ALSO ON SCENE. OFFICER CASHMAN TOOK 23 PHOTOGRAPHS OF BOTH SUBJECTS AND ALSO THE CHRYSLER WHICH HAD A DENT IN THE SIDE. I WAS LATER INFORMED THAT THE REAR VIEW MIRROR HAD BEEN CRACKED AS WELL, THOUGH OFFICER CASHMAN DID NOT GET A PHOTOGRAPH OF THAT PARTICULAR DAMAGE. I HAD ASKED DERRICK TO GET A HOLD OF HIS COMMAND AND HAVE THEM MAKE THE SCENE. FORT WAYNE POLICE SGT SAM ADAMS MADE THE SCENE ALONG WITH LT GROTE AND DEPUTY CHIEF BENDER. I MADE SURE THEY WERE AWARE OF WHAT WE HAD BEEN TOLD BY ALL PARTIES INVOLVED AND WHAT OUR INTENTIONS WERE FOR HANDLING THE INVESTIGATION.

I CONSULTED WITH CORPORAL UETRECHT AND DECIDED DUE TO THE CONFLICT IN REGARDS TO WHO WAS THE AGGRESSOR, DERRICK'S STATEMENT THAT [REDACTED] AND ADRIAN WERE AGGRESSIVELY IN HIS FACE AND [REDACTED] AND ADRIAN'S STATEMENTS THAT DERRICK HAD BEGAN PUSHING THEM FIRST, I DECIDED TO REFER ALL PARTIES TO THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE. I OBTAINED WRITTEN STATEMENTS FROM ALL INVOLVED AND ALSO A MEDICAL RELEASE FORM FOR [REDACTED], AS HIS PARENTS WERE GOING TO TAKE [REDACTED] TO THE EMERGENCY ROOM TO BE CHECKED OUT. I SPOKE WITH EVERYONE INVOLVED AND EXPLAINED WHAT I WAS DOING AND WHY, ISSUED THEM CONTROL NUMBERS FOR THIS REPORT AND ANSWERED ANY QUESTIONS THEY HAD. I TURNED ALL WITNESS STATEMENTS AND THE RELEASE FORM IN WITH THIS REPORT AND THEN CLEARED THE ASSIGNMENT.

[Narrative]

ON 11/04/2017, I OFFICER CASHMAN #326 WITH OFFICER STUCKEY #280 RESPONDED TO 1511 MILLENNIUM CROSSING REFERENCE A BATTERY THAT HAD JUST OCCURRED. UPON ARRIVAL ON SCENE, OTHER COUNTY OFFICERS AND A CITY OFFICER WERE ALREADY ON SCENE.

I MADE CONTACT WITH [REDACTED] GONZALES (DOB [REDACTED]), WHO STATED THAT HE BEEN ASSAULTED. I ASKED [REDACTED] WHAT HAD HAPPENED AND HE EXPLAINED THAT HE AND HIS COUSIN, ADRIAN LOWE (DOB [REDACTED]) WERE DRIVING IN THE ROUNDABOUT AT UNION CHAPEL AND AUBURN ROAD. [REDACTED] INFORMED ME THAT AS THEY WERE DRIVING THROUGH THE ROUNDABOUT TO EXIT ONTO NORTHBOUND AUBURN ROAD, A DARK GMC YUKON (INDIANA PLATE-[REDACTED]) FAILED TO YIELD TO THEM AND CUT THEM OFF IN THE ROUNDABOUT. [REDACTED] STATED THAT WHEN BOTH VEHICLES EXITED ONTO AUBURN ROAD, [REDACTED] AND ADRIAN FLASHED THEIR BRIGHTS AT THE YUKON AND PASSED THEM.

[REDACTED] THEN CLAIMED THAT THE YUKON FOLLOWED THEM TO [REDACTED]'S RESIDENCE AT [REDACTED] MILLENNIUM CROSSING. HE STATED THAT THE YUKON PARKED IN FRONT OF THE HOUSE. [REDACTED] STATED THAT THEY HAD WALKED SLIGHTLY TOWARDS THE YUKON BUT THEN WENT TOWARDS THE HOUSE. [REDACTED] INFORMED ME THAT A FEMALE IN THE YUKON THEN ROLLED DOWN THE WINDOW AND BEGAN YELLING AT HIM. A MALE, LATER IDENTIFIED AS DERRICK WESTFIELD (DOB [REDACTED]) EXITED THE YUKON AND THEY BEGAN YELLING AT EACH OTHER. [REDACTED] STATED THAT HE AND DERRICK BEGAN PUSHING EACH OTHER. [REDACTED] CLAIMED THAT DERRICK THEN STATED THAT HE WAS A POLICE OFFICER AND TO GET BACK. [REDACTED] STATED THAT THEY CONTINUED TO SHOVE EACH OTHER AND THEN BEGAN WRESTLING.

ADRIAN STATED THAT WHEN [REDACTED] AND DERRICK BEGAN FIGHTING, HE WENT INSIDE TO GET HELP. IN THE PROCESS OF WRESTLING ON THE GROUND, [REDACTED] STATED THAT HE WAS TRIPPED AND HE SMACKED HIS FACE ON THE GROUND. HE STATED THAT DERRICK ALSO THREW HIS GLASSES AWAY FROM HIM. AT SOME POINT WHILE DERRICK AND [REDACTED] WERE WRESTLING ON THE GROUND, ONE OF THEM WAS SLAMMED INTO THE SIDE OF ADRIAN'S CAR (INDIANA PLATE [REDACTED]), DENTING THE SIDE OF THE DRIVER'S DOOR AND CRACKING THE DRIVER SIDE OUTSIDE MIRROR. [REDACTED] STATED THAT HIS FATHER, JOHN GONZALES (DOB [REDACTED]) CAME OUTSIDE AND BEGAN TO YELL FOR DERRICK TO GET OFF OF HIS SON. DERRICK SHOUTED THAT HE WAS A POLICE OFFICER AND JOHN DID AS WELL. DERRICK AND [REDACTED] EVENTUALLY STOPPED FIGHTING AND THE POLICE WERE CALLED.

AFTER GATHERING [REDACTED]'S SIDE OF THE STORY, OFFICER ROGERS #323 PROVIDED ME WITH HIS CAMERA TO TAKE PHOTOGRAPHS. I TOOK PHOTOGRAPHS OF [REDACTED]'S INJURIES, INCLUDING THE INJURIES TO HIS NOSE, THE BACK OF HIS HEAD, AND HIS LEFT HAND. I ALSO TOOK PHOTOGRAPHS OF DERRICK'S FACE, AS HE STATED THAT [REDACTED] HAD PUNCHED HIM IN THE FACE. I COULD NOT SMELL ANY ODOR OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE ON DERRICK, AS [REDACTED] CLAIMED HE HAD SMELLED ON HIM DURING THE FIGHT. FINALLY, I TOOK PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE VEHICLE DAMAGED DURING THE FIGHTING. I THEN RETURNED OFFICER ROGERS' CAMERA AS HE STATED HE WOULD INPUT THE PICTURES INTO VERIPIC.

ACPD AND FORT WAYNE PD COMMAND MEMBERS HAD ARRIVED ON SCENE TO ASSESS THE SITUATION. AS THEY DID THIS, I STOOD BY OUTSIDE THE RESIDENCE. ONCE OFFICERS WERE FINISHED WITH THE INVESTIGATION, I CLEARED THE CALL AND TYPED AN ELECTRONIC SUPPLEMENT REPORT.

ON NOVEMBER 5TH, 2017 I, OFFICER ROGERS ASSISTED OFFICER I. HERRIOTT, ACPD#283 AT [REDACTED] MILLENNIUM XING.

WHEN I ARRIVED THERE WERE ALREADY OTHER OFFICERS ON SCENE SPEAKING TO ALL PARTIES INVOLVED. BOTH THE VICTIM AND SUSPECT WERE BOTH STILL ON SCENE AS WELL AS FAMILY MEMBERS OF THE VICTIM. THE FAMILY WAS STANDING OUTSIDE OF THE RESIDENCE WHILE THE SUSPECT WAS STANDING BY HIS VEHICLE IN THE ROADWAY IN FRONT OF THE RESIDENCE.

WHILE ON SCENE I STOOD IN THE MIDDLE OF THE LAWN BETWEEN BOTH PARTIES TO ENSURE NO FURTHER ISSUES AROSE. WHILE STANDING THERE, THE FATHER OF ONE OF THE INDIVIDUALS INVOLVED (VICTIMS COUSINS) ARRIVED AND WAS VERY ANGRY, HE STARTED TO BECOME LOUD AND MAKE COMMENTS TOWARDS THE SUSPECT. I TOLD HIM TO STOP AND TO MOVE UP TOWARDS THE HOUSE WHERE EVERYONE ELSE WAS WHICH HE DID.

THERE WERE NO OTHER ISSUES FROM ANY OF THE INDIVIDUALS AT THE RESIDENCE. OFFICER S. STUCKEY, ACPD#280 ASKED ME IF I HAD A CAMERA READILY AVAILABLE WHICH I SAID YES AND RETRIEVED MY CAMERA. HE THEN HAD OFFICER C. CASHMAN, ACPD #326 TAKE PICTURES OF THE VICTIM INJURIES, THE SUSPECT INJURIES AND THE VEHICLE THAT WAS INVOLVED IN THE ALTERCATION. ONCE OFFICER CASHMAN WAS COMPLETE TAKING PICTURES (23 PICTURES TOTAL TAKEN), I COLLECTED THE CAMERA. THE 23 PICTURES TAKEN WILL BE SUBMITTED INTO VERIPIC. I THEN ASKED OFFICER I. HERRIOTT IF SHE NEEDED ANYTHING ELSE BUT SHE SAID NO.

I THEN CLEARED THE SCENE, COMPLETED THIS ELECTRONIC REPORT AND RETURNED TO SERVICE.
